

RoHS Declaration of Conformity (2026)



1. Declaration

Belcom Cables Ltd hereby declares that all products placed on the EU market by the company conform to the applicable requirements of the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) legislation.

This declaration applies to the full product portfolio of Belcom Cables Ltd and is valid for all products that fall within the scope of Directive 2011/65/EU, as amended.

2. Applicable Legislation

This Declaration of Conformity is issued under:

Primary RoHS Legislation

- Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2) on the restriction of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

Substance Restriction Amendment

- Directive (EU) 2015/863, adding four phthalates (DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP) to Annex II restrictions.
(Referenced in your original document and still valid.)

Relevant 2024–2026 Delegated Directives

Belcom Cables Ltd acknowledges and operates in compliance with the following updates:

- Commission Delegated Directives published 21 November 2025, introducing centralized revisions to multiple lead related exemptions, including steel, aluminium, copper, glass, ceramics, and high melting solders.
- Delegated Directives entering into force July 1, 2026, tightening or revoking lead allowances in aluminium, soldering applications, and materials with new expiry and transitional periods.

3. Substance Restrictions

All Belcom Cables Ltd products conform to the maximum concentration limits specified in Annex II of Directive 2011/65/EU, as amended:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent Chromium (Cr6+)
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)
- DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP (phthalates)

Where applicable, Belcom Cables Ltd ensures proper assessment of restricted substances using established testing and supplier verification processes in accordance with IEC 63000 (Technical Documentation for RoHS).

4. Exemptions

Where Belcom Cables Ltd relies on exemptions under Annex III or Annex IV, such exemptions remain valid only under the updated 2024–2026 exemption framework, which includes:

- Narrower application specific sub entries
- Fixed expiry dates
- Requirement that renewal applications submitted within the allowed period preserve validity until Commission decision

Belcom Cables Ltd monitors all exemption status changes and ensures that no expired exemption is used in any product placed on the EU market after the relevant deadline.
